VILLA LA VERNEHOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION SATELLITE DISH POLICY

The Villa La Verne Homeowner's Association Board of Directors, in accordance with the California Civil Code, must make certain stipulations regarding the installation of satellite dishes.

Satellite dishes do not require architectural approval but an architectural form and inspection must be completed in order to:

- Guarantee installation in an approved location
- Guarantee that the wire leading from the unit to the satellite dish is of the approved length.
- Collect a deposit of \$75.00. This deposit will be used when the unit is sold and the dish is removed to repair and repaint. If the seller and buyer agree to leave the dish in place, the deposit will be returned to the seller. The new owner will then be required to make a deposit.

The Civil code states that the Board of Directors cannot deny a homeowner approval for installation of a satellite dish inside his unit or in his exclusive use common area patio.

However, certain restrictions do apply:

- A satellite dish may **under no circumstances** be mounted anywhere on the roof or the outside wall of the unit or anywhere else on the common area.
- Camouflage may be required if there is no interference with reception or the expense of such camouflage is not unreasonable (California Civil code, Section 1376). A summary of the Civil Code is listed below.
